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Outline	The Perceptual and Cognitive Neuroscience Laboratory in the Graduate School of Frontier Biosciences at Osaka University is looking for an academic staff member (assistant professor or associate professor). We study neural representations underlying perception and cognition using quantitative modeling approaches and large-scale brain activity measurement techniques. The successful candidate will contribute to conducting and developing research programs with Professor Shinji Nishimoto. The successful candidate will also teach or supervise undergraduate and graduate students in the lab and classes at the Graduate School of Frontier Biosciences, School of Engineering Science, and Center for Education in Liberal Arts and Sciences.
