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Outline	The Photophysics Laboratory, Graduate School of Frontier Biosciences, the University of Osaka, is studying the electronic structure of functional materials, including strongly correlated electron systems, biomaterials, and related materials, and developing novel spectroscopies using quantum beams including synchrotron radiation, lasers, and highly brilliant electron beams. The laboratory is seeking an Associate Professor with a flexible attitude who can contribute to advancing and leveraging the strengths of the laboratory's research. The successful applicant will be responsible for conducting research as well as teaching liberal arts and other subjects at both the undergraduate and graduate levels of physics, in collaboration with Professor Shin-ichi Kimura of the laboratory.
